

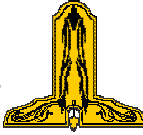
# Good of the Order

determined to seek the Light,

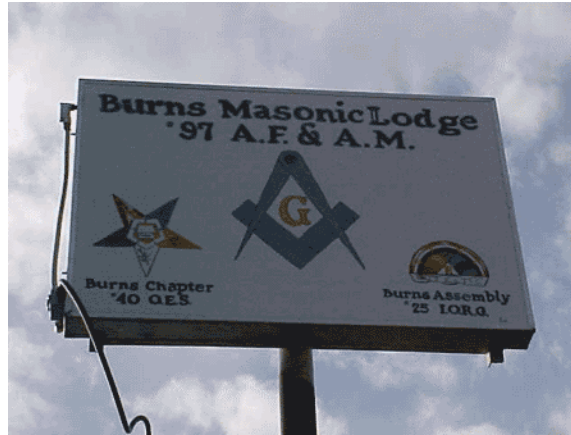
Never faltering or complaining,

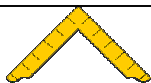
Bro. Howard Kahn is at the Harney District Hospital, recovering from a broken hip.

### Greetings Brethren,

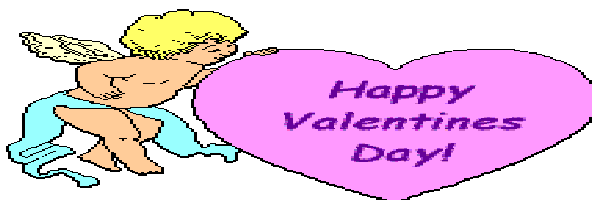
As we embark on a new year I hope good health is with all of you and your families. For those of you not in attendance for lodge on our 1<sup>st</sup> stated meeting, I am pleased to announce that WB Ray Breshears has been appointed Deputy District for our District #19, (new #). Congratulations to RWB Breshears. The dinner at the last meeting, hosted by the Baker Valley Scottish Rite was excellent and the Fellowship was great.

Let's talk a minute about a new program for the Cave, "Rope-A- Mason". The officers and attending brethren totally endorsed this program at the first January 2008 Stated Meeting. The idea was developed primarily to increase attendance at our annual cave meeting. The idea has a very simple formula. If a brother attended the cave meeting in 2007 and returns in 2008 with a mason who has never attended, or hasn't attended for 10 years or more, the returning brother receives an automatic 25% discount from his Cave fees. The scale continues, for example, if he brings 2 new masons his discount is 50%, 3 new masons 75%, and 4 new masons 100%. So let's all do our best to Rope-A- Mason to the Cave and increase our attendance.

I know the new committees are hard at work. There are a lot of important decisions to be made. I'm confident their efforts will be fruitful and positive. Our finance committee did a lot of work on new investment ideas with good debate before making a presentation to the Brethren. Our Building committee has been working with a contractor, on the issues with the heating system. They are doing great work and I know positive results will occur.
